Incident Reported at Centennial Regional High School

Saint-Hubert, February 16, 2018 – Last night a threat potentially involving a Centennial student was circulated on social media. The police were contacted through a 911 call regarding the situation. The police then communicated with the school principal overnight and worked with her to obtain the necessary information.

A student has been apprehended and is in police custody. Police are conducting an investigation into the situation.

Classes will continue as usual at the school today. The administration will be meeting with staff and students to address the situation and to reassure them.

Riverside School Board always takes threats of any kind very seriously. We are proud of the way our administration and police department worked together to identify the source of this threat and to make sure that any potential danger to our students and staff was neutralized.

The threat of violence at school can cause anxiety to students. Support services are made available at school. Please take a moment to talk to your children and if we can be of further assistance, do not hesitate to contact the school administration.
