SPEECH THERAPIST/PATHOLOGIST (80%)

This **temporary full-time position** will be available from April 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019 at St. Jude School located at 781 Miller, in Greenfield Park.

NATURE OF WORK:

The successful candidate will be responsible for the detection and evaluation of students experiencing or likely to experience learning, language, speech or voice problems and for determining a treatment and intervention plan focusing on prevention, re-adaptation or rehabilitation under the supervision of the Principal of St. Jude School.

DUTIES:

The responsibilities of the position include:

- the screening and evaluation of students with language and speech difficulties, whether in small groups or individually;
- the preparation of reports with recommendations for use at school and/or at home; supporting teachers in understanding the student's needs so that the teacher can adapt materials and teaching to meet those needs;
- the development of therapeutic intervention plans for students in coordination with the students' teachers and technicians;
- the training of adults to provide support in speech and language intervention to students;
- some individual therapy sessions for students as needed;
- the planning and presenting of in-service activities to teachers and administrators;
- liaison with other professionals both internal and external to the Board;
- participation with a multidisciplinary team in the development, review and implementation of I.E.P.s;
- any other related tasks.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate will be a member of l'Ordre professionnel des orthophonistes et audiologistes du Québec.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- At least one year's experience working in a public school system
- Must be fluent in English, both in oral and written, and working proficiency in French.
- Demonstrated leadership and initiative in his or her field of expertise.

ANNUAL SALARY:

In accordance with the Professionals' Agreement: \$34,912.80 to \$64,457.60 per year (28-hour week), according to qualifications and experience.
