Applicants are invited for a **regular full-time position** as Special Education Consultant. This position will be available as of July 2, 2019.

ASSIGNMENT:

The successful candidate will work with schools to assist them in the adaptation and development of appropriate pedagogical approaches for their students with special needs. Specifically, the task will include:

- working as a member of the Complementary Services team in order to provide pedagogical and student services to teachers, students, and administrators;
- providing support to teachers in the adaptation of programs for students with handicaps;
- evaluating student needs and growth by means of a variety of educational assessment strategies;
- supporting the development of individual educational plans (IEP) which link directly with reporting procedures to parents;
- training teachers in the use of approaches and strategies, practices and pedagogical materials for students with special needs;
- helping schools to develop special projects;
- representing the Board on local, regional and provincial committees, as requested;
- Other related duties, as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Special Education Consultant will be a qualified teacher with a Bachelor's degree in education.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

A Master's degree in Special Education or in the Teaching of Reading, successful teaching experience and experience as a Resources Teacher are strong assets. The successful candidate will be able to communicate effectively in English and French. He/she will have demonstrated proven skills working in a multi-disciplinary team. He or she will have a sound knowledge of the required curriculum, as well as an understanding of the most current research and best practices in the field of special education as it relates to regular education. Computer literacy is required. The Special Education Consultant will become a member of the Educational Services team and be responsible to the Director of Complementary Services.
