



## St-Lambert Wave Against Bullying

**October 29, 2013**— In 2009, The Family Channel invited all schools to Join the Wave and Stand Up against Bullying. They held an event across Canada and formed a human wave from coast to coast that was televised. A grade 5 student at St. Lambert Elementary named Emilie Burtolussi-Courval asked her principal if her school could do a wave to stand up against bullying.

All students from St. Lambert Elementary formed a line from the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor to the basement and created a wave. The next year the school decided to take the wave outside and invited all schools on Green Street to participate.
