## **GRADE 6 MATH BOOST CAMP**

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(60 hours)

2 week Math Boost Camp from **July 8 to July 19, 2019** (9am – 4pm)

The camp is intended for students who are experiencing difficulties in mathematics. Students <u>must</u> have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A referral from one's elementary school principal is a prerequisite.

Students who register for this course will participate in 30 hours of mathematics to prepare them for grade 7. The focus will be on improving basic skills and competency through hands-on activities with experienced math teachers. In addition, students will take part in 30 hours of multi-sport recreational activities.

**REGISTRATION:** Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by May 24, 2019

**COST:** \$325 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools

\$425 for outside candidates (if space available)

This course is geared to students who need Scientific and Technical Mathematics 426 or Scientific Mathematics 426 as a prerequisite for entry into certain CEGEP programs.

Students **must** be recommended by their school administration.
