As always, violent accessories such as guns and swords are not permitted.

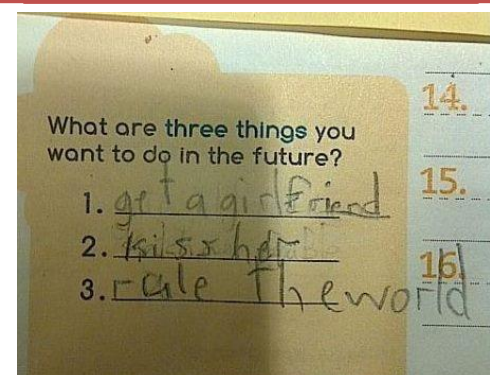
Vaccinations for grade 4
