Subject: COVID-19 Emergency Daycare Services

Riverside School Board will be offering emergency daycare services only to children of personnel from the health sector and from sectors providing essential services (police, paramedics, fire departments, etc.) as identified by the government and who have no other options. These services will also be available for daycare technicians and personnel who will be providing these emergency daycare services.

This is an exceptional service, for people who work in “essential” services and who have no other alternative.

The services will be offered:

- From March 16 to 27, 2020 inclusive;
- From 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday;
- For children aged 4 to 12 who currently attend 4-Year-Old Kindergarten, 5-Year-Old Kindergarten and primary school (public or private, English or French).

Parents will not be charged for the emergency daycare services.

No meals or snacks will be offered or provided. Therefore, you must provide a lunch box for your child. Only cold meals and thermos will be accepted.

Riverside Schools that are Offering Emergency Daycare Services:

REGISTRATION:

In order to receive the service, the children need to be registered.

- Only one form per family must be completed.
- Information about each child is requested.



- Registration must be repeated for each day of care required.

When you come to pick up your child, you will be asked to:

- Indicate the health insurance number of each of the children enrolled;
- Provide proof that you are part of the personnel entitled to the service (ex.: pay slip);
- Specify the needs of the children registered if applicable (including allergies).

Only the parent entitled to the service and the people authorized (including the other parent) will be able to pick up the children.
