Advisory Committee for Services to Students with Special Needs (ACSSSN)

If you have a child with special needs and want to share your experience and knowledge to serve other students in the educational community, you may be interested in participating in the Parents Advisory Committee for Services to Students with Special Needs (ACSSSN).

ACSSSN is a committee that each school board is required to establish to provide advice on the organization of services for students with special needs. It consists mostly of parents, who sit alongside the representatives of the school board with representation from various categories of staff working with our children. The committee meets approximately five times during the school year.

Participation in ACSSSN provides parents with the opportunity to interact with decision-makers and advise on the organization of services for students with special needs and the allocation of financial resources.

Parent members of the committee represent all of the parents of Students with Special Needs, with an obligation to express parental vision, to establish links with parents from other parent committee structures, and to ask questions about the services offered to students.
