81% of students mentioned that they feel safe at CPI.

Zones.

Overall,  
5.4% of girls and 3.1% of boys in Courtland Park International indicated that they did not feel safe at school. A further 13.5% of girls and 12.5% of boys indicated a neutral position, neither agreeing nor disagreeing that they felt safe at school. Areas outside of school are mainly places where students feel unsafe (bus, school yard and hallways.. These areas should be looked at closely in 2022-2023. Also, extracurricular activities will be back next =school year, so this should also have an impact on social interactions.

Verbal and social bullying is the highest rate, so it should be the main focus with our Behavior technician who will focus more on prevention.
