## DIRECTOR GENERAL

The Council of Commissioners of Riverside School Board (RSB) is seeking a strong educational leader with a proven track record to serve as its next Director General.

The selected candidate will be responsible for the management of activities, programs, services, and resources of RSB elementary and secondary schools, adult and vocational education centres, and administrative units. The Director General is responsible to the Council of Commissioners and will oversee the implementation its decisions in accordance with the law and regulations in force.

One of Quebec's nine English public-school boards, Riverside is committed to providing an engaging, inclusive, adaptive and bilingual environment that empowers learners to achieve their full potential. The board provides educational programs and services to youth and adult students on the South Shore of Montreal and is the birthplace of French Immersion. It serves over 9300 students in 22 schools, 4000 students in 5 centres and employs more than 2450 employees, including teachers and non-teaching staff. RSB has one of the highest graduation rates in Quebec, placing consistently among the top 5 of 72 school boards and school service centres.
