

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to inform you of an important policy change that will take effect at the **start of the new school year**. In accordance with new directives issued by the **Ministère de l'Éducation du Québec (MEQ)**, our school will be implementing updated cell phone regulations for all students.

Effective September 2:

- Cell phone use will not be permitted anywhere on school property during the school day, unless
 specifically authorized by school administration (i.e. for medical adaptations).
- All cell phones must be turned off and stored in lockers upon arrival and must remain out of sight until the end of the school day.
- Use of phones during class time, lunch, recess, in restrooms, or between classes is not allowed.
- Earbuds, headphones, smartwatches, and other personal electronic devices must also be stored in lockers and may not be used to communicate or access the internet during school hours.
- If a student needs to contact a parent or guardian, they will be permitted to do so through the school office.

These new regulations reflect the MEQ's commitment to reducing distractions, supporting student well-being, and promoting a learning environment that prioritizes engagement and respect.
