Procedure for Visits by Members of Parliament, Members of the National Assembly (MNAs) and Elected Members of Municipal Bodies

(adopted at DCM on November 10, 2025)

We greatly value the opportunity to welcome our MPs, MNAs, Mayors and City Councillors. Organizing classroom visits and interactive exchanges is an excellent way to enrich the educational experience for students and can inspire them and promote civic engagement, which remains a priority for us. We strongly believe that collaboration with our community leaders fosters stronger community bonds and encourages greater engagement on their part.

The following procedure must be observed when receiving politicians in order to ensure consistency throughout the school board:

- 1. Every politician or political attaché who wishes to visit one of our establishments must first contact the Office of the Director General (ODG)
- 2. The ODG will then coordinate a suitable date and time for the visit with the politician and a representative from the Council of Commissioners as well as with the administrator of the establishment, RSB's communications team, etc.) to ensure the visit is comprehensive and engaging for everyone. Visits are not to be scheduled at the end of the school year as it is an extremely busy time for everyone.
