



In partnership with the **Riverside School Board**, **LEARN Virtual Summer School** is an option available to the following students this year:

- Students who have already taken the course and who got a final mark over 49% (or pre-requisite credits for bridge courses).
- Students must be approved by their school board.

**Where:**

- **All classes are offered online** using Zoom and Google Classroom. Students will be provided with Quick Start Guides to help them participate fully.

**Evaluation:**

- LEARN summer school teachers will provide instruction and assessment. Competency evaluation, where required, will be integrated into class time.
- Virtual Summer School students must contact their school board to register for MEQ exams where required.
- Feedback and attendance information will be provided to families and school boards during the summer school period
- Final results will be sent directly to the School Board, not families, at the end of the summer school session.

**Please note:**

- **Courses may be scheduled in the morning or afternoon, depending on demand and teacher availability. See the included schedule. Daily attendance is required.**
- Students may register for a maximum of two courses. Please fill in the registration form separately for each summer course.
