9.2.1. P11 is a form provided by HR at RSB that administrators fill out with new registrations. March 21st, 2025, there were 271 registrations. 139 in English and 132 in immersion program. Created 7 groups in each program. March 26th, 2026, 256 registrations so far, a decline from 2025. 132 in English and 124 in immersion. Sandra presented the staffing document which included how admissions are separated, based on child needs, etc. Losses of students can create situations where more split classes happen, which is difficult pedagogically and difficult for staff retention as well. Discussion ensues us to think about how to make Mountainview sustainable and find innovative ways. GB is invited to reflect on the future of Mountainview and maintaining our
